Vehicle TATA 207 bearing registration No.PB-11-CJ-1664, owned by the petitioner was impounded as a case property during investigation of case FIR No.256 dated 23.12.2018 registered under Section 13(2) of Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan and Gausamvardhan Act, 2015 and Section 11 of Prevention of cruelty to Animals Act, 1960 at Police Station Bilaspur, District Yamuna Nagar.

Application moved by the petitioner for releasing the afore-said vehicle on superdari was dismissed by the trial Court vide order dated 13.05.2019 (Annexure P.3). Revision against that order was dismissed by learned Court of Sessions vide order dated 11.11.2020 (Annexure P.6) due to which petitioner has to approach this Court.

Today, it is informed by learned counsel for petitioner that all the accused involved in the afore-said case FIR No.256 dated 23.12.2018 has since been acquitted vide judgment dated 22.09.2022 copy of which has been placed on record.

Learned State Counsel does not dispute the afore-said facts.

Since the trial has concluded and the accused involved in the present case have since been acquitted, therefore, TATA Vehicle in question owned by the petitioner is directed to be released immediately to its registered owner.
