Challenge in the present petition is to the order dated 08.03.2019 (Annexure P-5), vide which the earlier order of the transfer/adjustment dated 22.02.2019, has been cancelled.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in violation of the transfer policy, the petitioner had been transferred from G.G.S.S.S.Assan to G.S.S.S.Nigdhu Karnal, vide order dated 06.12.2018; that earlier also, the petitioner was also transferred to various places, but he had never challenged the same, and that vide order dated 03.04.2019 passed by a Coordinate Bench, operation of the impugned order dated 08.03.2019 had been stayed.

On the other hand, learned State counsel submits that by way of exhausting remedy available under Clause 6 of the Transfer Policy 2010-11, the petitioner is to approach the concerned authority within 15 days of such transfer before approaching this Court and that the concerned authority can rectify such transfer orders in case the same are made in violation of the policy.

At this stage, learned State counsel, on instructions from Sandeep Kumar, L.A., Secondary Education, submits that the petitioner would not be dislocated from his present place of posting i.e. GHS Kundal, District Sonipat, till the next transfer drive is held, and that whenever the transfer drive is held, the petitioner is to participate in it.

In view of the offer given by the learned State counsel, the present petition is disposed of.

Needless to say that the petitioner would participate in the next transfer drive as and when held.
