As reported by the Registry, the notice issued to the appellant has been received back with the report that no such person was found to be residing at the given address and the notice sent to the respondent has been returned with the report that he has died.

2. On 29.11.2022, the appellant as well as the respondent had remained unrepresented and the Registry had been directed to inform their counsel regarding the next date of hearing, well in advance.

As mentioned in the order dated 03.02.2023, the Registry had reported that the letter issued to learned counsel for the appellant had been received back unserved and learned counsel for the respondent had been informed regarding the appeal vide the separate letter but both the parties had remained unrepresented on that day also and therefore, notices were

ordered to be issued to the appellant as well as the respondent for today.

4. However, none has appeared in the Court on behalf of the appellant.

5. In view of the above-discussed scenario, this Court is left with no option but to dismiss the appeal in hand for the want of prosecution. Resultantly, the same stands dismissed accordingly.
