MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J.

Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for directing respondent Nos. 2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners.

[2] Status report by way of affidavit dated 05.04.2023 of Sh. Subhash Chander, DSP, HQ, Kurukshetra, on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 3, has been filed. Same is taken on record and copy thereof supplied to the opposite side.

Registry will do the needful.

[3] A perusal of Para Nos. 2 & 3 of above affidavit reveal that there is no threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners. For reference, above paras are re-capitulated as under:-

“2. That after receiving the orders of this Hon’ble Court the respondent no. 2 and 3 inquired the matter and found that

there was no threat perception. After that ASI Jugal Kishor No. 112/KKR, Police Station Krishna Gata, Thanesar, District Kurukshetra was deputed and directed him to enquire the matter.

3. *Thereafter ASI Jugal Kishore went to the given address of the present petitioners but they have not met on the given address but the respondent no. 4 to 7 were met and they have given their statements that they will not cause any harm to the petitioners and they have also stated that they have no objection on the marriage of present petitioners. Copies of statements of respondent no. 4 to 7 are enclosed herewith as Annexure R-1 to R-4 for kind perusal of this Hon'ble Court."*

[4] In view of the stand taken by respondents, learned counsel, on instructions from petitioners, does not press the present petition any further.

[5] Disposed off accordingly.

Needless to say that the respondents shall be bound by the averments made in the affidavit noticed here-above.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
