This is the petitioner's fourth attempt to get bail, pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.102 dated 02.07.2019 registered under Section 21, 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (hereinafter referred to as '1985 Act'), later on added Section 25, 29, 61/85 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station City Nawanshahr, District S.B.S. Nagar.

2, As per the case of the prosecution, co-accused Sunny was arrested with 20 injections of Buprethorphone and 20 gram heroin. During the interrogation, it was disclosed that the petitioner has supplied 150 grams of heroin. Thus, the petitioner was also made a co-accused. The learned counsel representing the petitioner contends that she is sought to be prosecuted merely on the basis of disclosure statement. Though, there is no recovery from the petitioner.

3. While dismissing the previous bail applications, it has been noticed that the petitioner has been convicted in as many as 12 cases under the NDPS Act, 1985. The learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that the contraband recovered in those cases does not fall in commercial quantity.

4. This Court has considered the submissions. Keeping in view the antecedents of the petitioner, this Court is not inclined to grant concession of bail to the petitioner. However, keeping in view the period of petitioner’s incarceration, the Special Court is requested to make sincere endeavour for expeditious disposal of the case preferably within a period of next nine months, positively.
5. With these observations, the present petition is disposed of.
6. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
