The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus or any other appropriate writ, order or directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of private respondents as the petitioners are residing together in the house of petitioner No.1 and intend to get married against the wishes of private respondents.

Precisely, in the context of aforesaid relief, petitioners have approached the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur-respondent No.2 by way of representation dated 26.03.2023 (Annexure P-3).

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sandeep Kumar, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents. A copy of the paper-book be handed over to him during the course of the day.

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Having heard learned counsel for the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, instant petition is *disposed of* with the direction to respondents No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur to look into the representation dated 26.03.2023 (Annexure P-3) of the petitioner by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within a period of one *month* from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

The petition is disposed of with the above directions.
