1. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the reply filed by the respondents wherein, the respondents have mentioned that appropriate instructions vide letter dated 24.12.2021 have already been issued to all the General Managers' Haryana Roadways not to make the driver's work for more than the hours prescribed in the said letter, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty that in case still, the drivers are made to work for more than the prescribed hours, the petitioners be given liberty to raise the said grievance before the authorities concerned.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that once as a Head of the Department has issued instructions to streamline the grievance of the petitioners that the drivers will only be required to perform specified

hours of the duty and they will also be entitled for consequent rest, they are supposed to be complied with by all the General Managers and in case, any violation of the said direction is brought to the notice of the Department, the same will not only be viewed seriously but appropriate action will also be taken after verifying the facts.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.

4. Ordered accordingly.
