JASJIT SINGH BEDI, J. (ORAL)

On 10.04.2023, the following order was passed in this case:-

“The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for quashing of the Order dated 15.02.2023 (Annexure P-3) passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Jalandhar vide whereby the bail of the petitioner stands cancelled. His bail bonds and surety bonds stands forfeited in case FIR No.62 dated 16.05.2019 under Sections 306/34 IPC P.S. Division No.8, Jalandhar Commissionerate.

The Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was initially granted bail vide order dated 25.07.2019 after which he was regularly appearing before the Trial Court. However, due to some miscommunication the impugned order came to be passed. He states that the petitioner is ready and willing to join the proceedings once again in accordance with law.

Notice of motion for 30.05.2023.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to surrender before the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate within a period of one week from today and subject to his depositing Rs.25,000/- as costs with Spinal Rehabilitation Centre, Chandigarh Plot No.1, Madhya Mnarg, Sector 28-A, Chandigarh, he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the Trial Court.”

On 30.05.2023, the following order was passed in this case:-

“On request, adjourned to 01.06.2023.

The learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to place on record the receipt with regard to deposit of Rs.25,000/- and a copy of the zimni order to show that the petitioner has been admitted to interim bail in terms of the order dated 10.04.2023 passed by this Court, on the next date of hearing.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in compliance of the aforementioned order, the petitioner has surrendered before the Trial Court and deposit a sum of ₹25,000/- as costs with Spinal Rehabilitation Centre, Chandigarh and released on interim bail. The receipt of the said payment is taken on record as Mark X.

In view of the above, no further order is required to be passed.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed off.

It is expected to this Court that the petitioner shall regularly appear before the trial Court and shall not absent himself from appearance but for sufficient cause.
