SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (Oral)

Grievance of the petitioner, who has retired from the post of Peon on 31.08.2022, is that the petitioner has not been paid the ACP, which were due to him in the years 2014 and 2022.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has served a legal notice dated 23.01.2023, Annexure P-7, upon the respondents, but to no avail. He submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to look into the same.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Pankaj Middha, Addl. A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Given the nature of order being passed, this Court does not deem it necessary to call upon the respondents to file a response.

Having heard counsel for the parties, but without commenting upon the claim of the petitioner, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to examine the legal notice, Annexure P-7, within a period of four months from the date of communication of a copy of this order.

In case, respondent No.3 finds that the claim of the petitioner is unfounded, an order be passed assigning reasons for its rejection.
