JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (ORAL)

1. Through this common order, the above captioned three
petitions are disposed of as all are inter-connected.

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2. On 22.05.2023, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submitted that on account of changed facts and circumstances, he is unable to pay agreed amount, however, he is ready to pay Rs.12 lacs in two installments i.e. Rs.6 lacs before the adjourned date and remaining amount of Rs.6 lacs within further two weeks towards full and final settlement of all pending cases.

Learned counsel for the respondent(s) submits that he has no objection to settle all disputes, subject to payment of Rs.12 lacs as agreed by learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of statement of both sides, the petitioner(s) is directed to bring demand draft of Rs.6 lacs in favour of the respondent on the next date of hearing.

Adjourned to 02.06.2023.

Interim order to continue.

3. In compliance of the afore-stated order, learned counsel for the petitioner has handed over Demand Draft No.077788 for a sum of Rs.6 Lacs to the learned counsel for the respondent.

4. Learned counsel for the respondent submits that divorce petition filed by the petitioner is pending before Additional District Judge, Chandigarh and the same is coming up for hearing on 14.07.2023.

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He further submits that the respondent would appear before the Trial Court and make a statement that she has no objection if petition seeking divorce is allowed and marriage is dissolved subject to payment of balance amount of Rs. 6 Lacs.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to pay agreed sum of Rs.6 Lacs on or before 14.07.2023 before Additional District Judge, Chandigarh.

6. Learned counsel for the respondent/wife-Dimple undertakes to withdraw her petition under Section 12 of Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 Act which is pending before Magistrate, Patiala.

7. In view of statements of both sides and financial arrangement arrived at between the parties, CRM-M-29239-2016, CRM-M-29243-2016 and CRM-M-39548-2016 are disposed of as infructuous.
