1. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the prayer of the petitioners in the present petition is that they should be granted further promotion on the post of Assistant.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that services of the petitioners were regularized under the policy dated 18.06.2014, which policy has already been set aside by the Division Bench of this Court while passing order in ***CWP No.17206 of 2014 titled as Yogesh Tyagi and another vs. State of Haryana and others, decided on 31.05.2018*** and consequently, the regularization of the services of the petitioners.

3. Learned counsel for the respondents further submits that the said judgment is under scrutiny before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India

wherein, status quo has been ordered hence, the petitioners continued working on the said post and if the prayer of the petitioners is accepted, same will be contrary to the stay granted by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

4. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further at this stage with liberty to the petitioners either to revive the present petition or file a fresh petition in case any right accrues in favour of the petitioners after the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

5. Ordered accordingly.

6. Civil miscellaneous application pending, if any, is also disposed of.
