Learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioner has been ordered to be acquitted by the learned trial Court and the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

As per order dated 12.02.2020, respondent No. 2 was directed to pay a costs of Rs. 2000/-, which was to be deposited with High Court legal Services Committee. As per the record, the said costs have not been deposited by respondent No. 2. Since, the parties have already compromised the matter and the petitioners stand acquitted, the respondent No. 2 is exempted from paying a sum of Rs. 2000/- as costs, in terms of order dated 12.02.2020.
