The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.8 dated 28.01.2007 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 323, 427, 447, 511, 148 and 149 IPC registered at Police Station Bhogpur, District Jalandhar and all other subsequent proceedings including the order dated 20.01.2010 (Annexure P-9).

The learned counsel for the petitioner has apprised the Court that in compliance with the order dated 10.08.2023, the petitioner has surrendered before the Trial Court, deposited the costs of Rs.1,00,000/- and has surrendered his passport as well. He further submits that the petitioner has been granted the concession of bail by the Trial Court.
