Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.277, dated 23.08.2022, registered at Police Station Bhuna, District Fatehabad, under Section 379 of IPC.

On 18.04.2023, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia submits that petitioner has merely been implicated on basis of disclosure made by co-accused Amrik Singh. Out of total 10 FIRs pending against him, he already stands acquitted in 9 FIRs while having been convicted in one.

Notice of motion for 20.07.2023.

Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Sr. DAG, Punjab., Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when required/called upon to do so and in the event of his arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating officer and shall also strictly abide by all the conditions as laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

As per status report file today on behalf of respondent-State, petitioner has joined the investigation and has fully cooperated and his police custody is not required.

However, learned State counsel has opposed the bail petition on the ground that petitioner is involved in many other cases, as per the details given in para No.9 of the status report.

Considering the fact that petitioner has already joined the investigation and his police custody is not required, the order dated 18.04.2023, is hereby made absolute.
