AMAN CHAUDHARY. J.

1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to the respondent Nos.2 to 5 not to harass the petitioner unnecessarily and to take fair, impartial and proper action on the representation dated 19.01.2022.

2. Learned State counsel submits that there were certain documents that were not supplied by the petitioner, which fact is controverted by learned counsel for the petitioner. However, in order to proceed with the matter, learned counsel for the petitioner fairly submits that the documents as required, will be submitted to the authorities once again, with a prayer that the enquiry be got conducted by a Senior Official, as there was one more enquiry conducted by the officer of the same rank i.e. DSP.

3. Learned State counsel has no objection to the prayer made.

4. In view of the above without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that the representation dated 19.01.2022, Annexure P-11 be considered by the respondent No.2 i.e. Senior

Superintendent of Police, upon receipt of the documents, which would be submitted by the petitioner within a period of 2 weeks from today in accordance with law.

5. Disposed of accordingly.
