Main case

Seeking protection of their life and liberty from the hands of
respondents No.4 to 8, the petitioners have come up before this Court.

2. On instructions from ASI Naresh Kumar, Police Station Sector
19, Chandigarh, counsel for UT submits that the FIR has been registered and
now the private respondents are not living in the said house because of the
registration of FIR against them.

3. Given above, since the threat is from the private respondents,
who according to the petitioners were forcibly living in their house and now
as per the instructions, they are absconding, no further orders are required to
pass in the present petition and the same is disposed of. It is clarified that in
case the petitioners feel any threat perception, liberty

reserved to the petitioners to approach this Court again. Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
