Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.11 dated 18.1.2022 registered under Sections 307, 323, 148, 149, 427, 120-B, 188 IPC and Section 51 of Disaster Management Act at Police Station Division No.8, District Ludhiana.

On 29.4.2022, the petitioner was granted interim bail with direction to join the investigation.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police in compliance of the aforesaid order of interim bail and further submits that now the parties have entered into compromise.

State counsel on instructions from ASI Naveen Kumar apprised the Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police and further that the case involves version and cross version and that now the

parties have entered into a compromise and that the petitioner is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 29.4.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
