The petitioner through instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is seeking direction to official respondents to look into the matter and proceed in accordance with law against private respondents in FIR No.203 dated 17.08.2015 under Sections 406 & 498-A of IPC registered at Police Station Shahkot, Police District Jalandhar City.

Mr. Ramandeep Singh Brar, learned counsel appearing for private respondents, submits that police after completing investigation filed its report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. against four persons and main accused i.e. Jaswant Singh (husband of the complainant) has passed away and Trial Court has ordered to abate trial against Jaswant Singh. He further submits that present petition has rendered infructuous in view of death of Jaswant Singh and pendency of trial qua others.

Dismissed as infructuous.

The petitioner is at liberty to move appropriate application if something survives.
