Short reply on behalf of respondent Nos.4 and 7 has been filed  
and the same is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to the  
counsel opposite.

2. Disheartened by the non-compliance of order dated 27.07.2023  
at this instance of respondent Nos.4 and 7, the petitioners prayed for  
directing the private respondents for compliance of the previous order in  
letter and spirit.

3. Counsel for the private respondents submits that due to non-  
cooperation of petitioners, the previous order could not be complied with,  
however, they are making their best efforts and persuading the child to  
interact with the petitioners. Respondent No.7 is present in person also

undertakes that in case the petitioners come to see the child, they will fully co-operate with the petitioners and will remain respectful to them.

4. Be that as it may. Let the counsel appearing for the parties either themselves or by authorizing any of their associates, preferably female, shall visit to the child along with petitioners and interact with the child. Parties through their counsel after consultation with each other will fix the date and place of such meeting. Needless to say that petitioners shall have all the legal rights which they can avail in accordance with law.

5. Counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are very poor and they are unable to bear the expenses of any litigation including filing fresh petition before this Court or any other Court of competent jurisdiction. Given such statement, petitioners are permitted to avail service of District Legal Aid Authority or State Legal Aid Authority as the case may be. In case, petitioners make any application for providing them counsel to the Secretary, State Legal Services Authority or Secretary District Legal Services Authority, the concerned officer shall provide them counsel and legal assistance without any delay.

6. Liberty further reserved to approach this Court again.
