Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.23 dated 17.3.2022 registered under Sections 307, 506 IPC (Section 115 IPC added later on) and Section 25 of Arms Act at Police Station Mukandpur, District SBS Nagar.

The allegations in brief against the present petitioner are that he supplied firearm which was used by co-accused Vinod Kumar at the time of the occurrence but no one sustained injuries on account of firing done by co-accused Vinod Kumar.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in compliance of the previous order. State counsel on instructions from ASI Kuldip Singh submits that the petitioner has cooperated with the police during the investigation and is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation. He further

apprised the Court that in this case, weapon used in the commission of the

crime already stands recovered from co-accused Vinod Kumar and Rajesh.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 18.5.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
