Petitioner has approached this Court praying for setting aside the impugned order dated 31.03.2022 passed by learned Sessions Judge, Kurukshetra in Appeal No.73/2022 dated 31.03.2022 vide which the petitioner was directed to pay 20% of compensation which was imposed upon him by trial Court in Complaint No.503/2017 dated 23.05.2017.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner fairly submits that the petitioner is an old aged person who is retired from service. She submits that she restricts her prayer to the extent that the appeal filed by the petitioner be decided expeditiously.

After hearing counsel for the petitioner and perusing the record, this Court finds the prayer made is genuine one and in the facts and circumstances of the case, present petition is disposed of with a request to the Appellate Court to decide the appeal filed by the petitioner expeditiously, preferably, within six months from today.
