The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for quashing of FIR No.106 dated 15.05.2023 registered under Sections 465, 467, 471, 420, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station City Moga, District Moga (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings including P.O. order dated 14.07.2008 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Moga.

After arguing at length for some time and faced with likely consequences, learned counsel for the petitioner restricted his prayer to the extent that the petitioner may be permitted to surrender before the trial Court and to file an application for grant of bail and the trial Court may be directed to decide the said application expeditiously.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court within 10 days from today and on doing so he may file an appropriate application for grant of bail and if any such application filed by the petitioner, the same shall be decided by the trial Court expeditiously.
