This appeal arises out of a suit for permanent injunction. Plaintiffs-Balkar Singh and another filed a suit alleging that no drain exists in the land owned by them.

Learned counsel for the appellants now states that this appeal has been rendered infructuous and be disposed of as such as the Kassi from which the water used to be taken, has since ceased to exist and even if the Khal was there, it has lost all meaning. No Khal as on date passes through the land of the appellants.
