HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that the claim of the petitioner(s) is squarely covered by the decision of the Coordinate Bench of this Court while passing order in *CWP No.24282 of 2011 titled as Jashwant Singh and others vs. State of Haryana and others, decided on 29.09.2016*, hence, the present writ petitions be also disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner(s) in terms of *Jashwant Singh's case (supra)*. Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) further submits that recently also, this Court while passing order in *CWP No.12858 of 2018, titled as Chand Singh and others vs.*

State of Haryana and others, decided on 24.08.2023, granted the benefit to the similarly situated employees, which judgment should also be kept in mind.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order, respondents will consider the claim of the petitioner(s) for the grant of benefits in terms of the decision in ***Jashwant Singh's case (supra)*** as well as in ***Chand Singh's case (supra)*** by passing appropriate speaking order and in case the petitioner(s) are found entitled for any relief, the same will also be extended to them within a further period of four weeks.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petitions may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further, at this stage.

4. Ordered accordingly.
