1. By way of present petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, prayer has been made for issuance of writ in the nature of *habeas corpus* directing the respondents to produce the wife of the petitioner, namely Manpreet Kaur.

On 03.05.2023, this Court passed the following order:-

Ms. Manpreet Kaur-detenu along with her father and SI Charan Singh, P. S. Samrala, are present in Court.

Manpreet Kaur-detenu has got recorded her statement with the concerned police station stating that she wanted to stay with her parents and family.

In view thereof, nothing substantial survives in the present petition, however, she also submits that she intends to pursue her further studies and her entire original certificates/testimonials are lying with the petitioner, thus,

petitioner is directed to come present in Court on 04.05.2023 along with her original certificates/testimonials."

2. Today, learned counsel for respondents No.5 and 6 filed reply and submits that he will not press for the return of the original certificates any more.
3. In view thereof, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
