Through the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioners seek issuance of directions to the State to take action against Deputy Superintendent of Police (Head Quarter), District Fazilka for allegedly putting pressure on the petitioners to enter into a compromise in FIR No.325 dated 25.12.2022 registered under Section 379-B IPC at Police Station City-1, Abohar, District Fazilka.

At the outset, learned State counsel submits that the State has fairly investigated the contents of the aforesaid FIR got lodged by the petitioners and found the same to be false and prepared a report seeking cancellation thereof and that the same shall be shortly filed before the competent Court seeking its approval.

In the light of the above, no orders need to be passed in the instant petition especially when the allegations made by the petitioners

against respondent No.3 are found to be vague.

It is clarified that as and when the State files the cancellation report before the competent Court, the petitioners would be at liberty to seek its rejection through a protest petition and that the dismissal of the present petition shall not stand in the way of the Court to decide the petitioners' protest petition, if any, on its merits, in accordance with law.
