This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the notification dated 25.04.2005 (Annexure P-2) issued by respondent No.2 and the prospectus for PMET-2005 issued by respondent No.1 to the extent that 13 seats each have been reserved for Non-Resident Indian students in the Government Medical College at Patiala and Amritsar and 4 seats at Faridkot and 7 seats have been reserved for NRI candidate in the Government Medical Dental Colleges at Patiala and Amritsar and other prayers have also been made.

The present writ petition was admitted on 26.07.2005 and had been ordered to be listed for final disposal within six months.

As per report of the Registry, the process fee was not filed by the petitioner and thus, service upon respondents could not be effected. It

is further noted that a letter had also been issued to counsel for the petitioner to provide process fee for completion of service and in this regard, learned counsel for the petitioner had stated that the petitioner had already got admission in some Medical College and is not interested in the present case any more.

Today, since no one has appeared on behalf of the petitioner, thus, the present writ petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.

However, the liberty is granted to the petitioner to move an application for restoration of the present writ petition in case any cause of action survives to the petitioner.
