**AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):**

1. The present petition has been filed for quashing of order dated 6<sup>th</sup> October, 2017 whereby petitioner was declared as proclaimed person in a complaint bearing No. NACT/14/2017 bearing file No. 6 of 20<sup>th</sup> January, 2017.

2. On 19<sup>th</sup> July, 2018, following order was passed:-

*“It has been submitted that the entire amount has been repaid. Reliance has been placed on the extract of demand and collection register issued by Field Officer, Punjab Backward Classes Land Development & Finance Corporation, which shows that an amount of Rs.41,650/- was due on 15.03.2015. This amount has been deposited by her vide receipt Nos.00095, 00096 and 00097 dated 31.05.2018.*

*Notice of motion for 21.11.2018.*

*Meanwhile, petitioner is directed to surrender before the learned trial Court within 10 days and on doing so, she shall be released on bail by that Court to its satisfaction.”*

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has

surrendered before the Court concerned and was released on bail.

4. In view of the above, no further directions are called for, the petition is disposed of as infructuous.
5. Since the main case has been disposed of as infructuous, pending application if any is rendered infructuous.
