VINOD S. BHARDWAJ, J. (ORAL)

The present writ petition has been preferred by the petitioner for seeking issuance of directions to the respondents to install the motor connection in the fields of the petitioner being the rightful owner.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondents/PSPCL contends that they have no objection to the release of motor connection in favour of the petitioner on his furnishing documents to establish his title on the property.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the same.

The present petition is accordingly disposed of with the following directions:-

- (i) That the petitioner may furnish the application for release of motor connection in his fields along with the requisite documents to the respondents establishing his ownership over the land within a period of 04 weeks after the receipt of a certified copy of this order;
- (ii) That upon submissions of the application accompanied by the requisite documents, the respondents would consider the case of the petitioner for release of the motor connection in his fields within a period of 04 weeks of submission of the application and shall intimate him the requisite shortcomings/demand of statutory charges for release of such connection;
- (iii) That upon the aforesaid application along with requisite documents/additional documents being communicated to by the respondents to the petitioner, the requisite documents along with statutory charges and fee shall be deposited by the petitioner within a period of 04 weeks thereafter; and
- (iv) In the event of the requisite documents/charges being deposited and the release of the motor connection being found feasible as per the mandate of the Electricity Act, 2003, the Electricity connection shall be released in favour of the petitioner within a period of 45 days of the application having been received complete in all respects along with all statutory charges.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
