Learned State counsel, on the basis of the affidavit of the Commandant, 82nd Battalion, PAP as well as on the basis of the affidavit of the Deputy Commissioner, Bathinda, submits that the entire payment has been made to the petitioner through treasury, however, the State Bank of India has deducted TDS of Rs. 6,56,711/- under the provisions of Income Tax Act. This fact is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the same, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to petitioner to file his income tax return to claim the refund of the income tax in accordance with law.
