1. The petitioner is seeking directions to official respondents to conduct a fair and impartial inquiry into the representations (Annexures P-1 and P-2) and to take legal action against the private respondents.

2. On the last date of hearing, learned State counsel on instructions had apprised the Court that no representation much less Annexure P-1 and Annexure P-2 dated 03.01.2019 and 10.01.2019 respectively, was ever received by the official respondents nor had any complaints been received against the private respondents, hence, there was no question of the official respondents conducting any inquiry into the allegations which stand levelled by the petitioner in the instant petition.

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3. On the last date as well there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner and the case was adjourned with directions to the Registry to intimate learned counsel for the petitioner about the date fixed.
4. As per office report, learned counsel for the petitioner was duly intimated by the Registry, however, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner today as well. It seems that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition.
5. Dismissed for non-prosecution.
