Present petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of respondents No.4 to 7 who are unnecessarily harassing the petitioner by time and again calling him to the police station concerned.

Counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that Mani daughter of the petitioner got married with respondent No.5 in the year 2012 but due to marital discord, the daughter of the petitioner left the matrimonial home. He further submits that there are allegations on the part of respondents No.4 to 7 that Mani left the matrimonial home and started living with some third person, in connivance with the present petitioner. He further submits that actually, the petitioner is not knowing the whereabouts of his daughter. He further contends that now local police is time and again

calling the petitioner to the police station at the instance of respondents No.4 to 7 and in this regard, one application dated 22.1.2022 (Annexure P-1) was also given to SHO of Police Station concerned but the police failed to take any action in this regard.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3.

Mr. C.L.Pawar, Addl. AG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and submits that in case any complaint/representation(s) has been filed, the concerned authorities will consider and decide the same as per law.

Counsel for the petitioner is agreed to the aforesaid proposal.

In view of above and without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and in case any threat perception is there, then to provide necessary protection, if the situation so warrants. Needful be done within next 2 months.
