The petitioner through instant petition under Section 482 Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is seeking directions to official respondents to take legal action against respondent No.3 who is threatening the petitioner that he would commit suicide if petitioner does not perform marriage with him.

Learned State counsel, at the outset, submits that petitioner has solemnized marriage and she is peacefully staying with her husband. There is no fresh complaint against respondent No.3. He assures the Court that jurisdictional SHO would take appropriate action against respondent No.3, if he threatens the petitioner or in any other way, attempts to cause injury.

In view of statement made by learned State counsel, the present petition is disposed of and no further order is warranted.
