The present revision petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of an appropriate order or direction to desist from taking up contempt proceedings *i.e.* CM-29-2018 being an application under Order XXXIX, Rule 2-A of the Code of Civil Procedure qua interim order dated 25.06.2018 passed by the trial Court.

Counsel for the petitioner has produced a copy of order dated 17.04.2013 passed by the trial Court in Civil Misc-29-2018 titled as '***Maharaja Aggarsain Trust (Regd.) and others vs. Sri Niwas Gupta and others***', to contend that the trial Court has already disposed of the application, holding that there is no intentional violation of the injunction order dated 25.06.2018 of the trial Court by the respondents.

Since the main issue qua contempt proceedings has already been disposed of by the trial Court, therefore, the present revision petition has been rendered infructuous.
