Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner got registered an FIR No. 19 dated 23.02.2023 under Sections 420, 120-B IPC at Police Station Sadar Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur (Annexure P-1). He submits that a civil suit between the parties is also pending before the Court of Civil Judge, (Senior Division), Gurdaspur, (Annexure P-3) and respondent No. 5, in order to pressurize the petitioner not to pursue the said civil suit, is also moving applications before the various authorities.
