MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J.

Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for directing respondent Nos. 1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners.

[2] Status report by way of affidavit dated 05.04.2023 of Sh. Yad Ram, DSP, Sirsa, on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 3, has been filed. Same is taken on record and copy thereof supplied to the opposite side.

Registry will do the needful.

[3] A perusal of Para No. 3 of above affidavit reveals that as on today, there is no threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners. For reference, above para is re-capitulated as under:-

“3. That the alleged representation Annexure P-4 was never moved by the petitioners or anybody else to the local police. Private respondents have stated in their statements that they

have no intention to cause any harm to the petitioners and will not cause any harm to petitioners. In this way there is no apprehension to the life and liberty to the petitioners from the private respondents. Under the facts and circumstances mentioned above, present petition is devoid of any merits and is liable to be dismissed.”

[4] Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Rajesh Kumar, has given an assurance that in case there is any threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners in future, they would be protected in accordance with law.

[5] In view of the above, present petition is disposed off accordingly.
