VIKRAM AGGARWAL, J (ORAL)

1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for the grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.250 dated 23.03.2023 (Annexure P-3) registered under Sections 406 and 420 IPC at Police Station Sadar Karnal, District Karnal (Haryana).

2. On 06.04.2023, the following order was passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court:-

“Contends inter alia that petitioner is ready to settle the matter on some amicable terms with the complainant side.

Notice of motion for 10.05.2023.

Mr. Kiran Pal Singh, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and seeks time to have instructions in the matter.

In the meanwhile, petitioner will join investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail, till the next date of hearing, on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) of Code

of Criminal Procedure, 1973.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 06.04.2023, the petitioner has joined investigation.
4. Learned counsel representing the State of Punjab, on instructions from SI Jasvinder, who is present in the Court submits that in compliance of the order dated 06.04.2023, the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the statement given by learned counsel representing the State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 06.04.2023 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to compliance of the provisions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
