DEEPAK SIBAL, J. (Oral)

Through the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.0063 dated 30.04.2016 registered under Sections 308, 323 and 34 IPC at Police Station Division B, Police Commissionerate, Amritsar.

At the outset, learned State counsel submits that the State had investigated the allegations made in the FIR in question and found them to be correct. Accordingly, a report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. had been filed before the competent court on the basis whereof the petitioners were charged to face trial under Sections 308, 323, 34 IPC and that in the course of such trial 09 out of 15 prosecution witnesses have also been examined.

In the light of the afore statement made by the learned State counsel, at this belated stage of the petitioners' trial, this Court is of the opinion that the prayer sought by the petitioners are not entitled to the aforesaid prayer of theirs.

Dismissed.

The trial court is directed to dispose of the petitioners' trial within 04 months from the next date already fixed before it, in accordance with law.
