1. Instant petition has been filed seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.3 to decide representation dated 01.10.2019 (Annexure P-3/T) and legal notice dated 26.02.2023 (Annexure P-7).
2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner's mother was working as a Peon on regular basis in the office of Executive Engineer, Bhiwani, W/S Division and died in harness on 29.05.2019. He submits that she was 51 years of age. Counsel submits that after coming into force the Haryana Civil Services (Compassionate Financial Assistance or Appointment) Rules, 2019, w.e.f., 01.08.2019 (Annexure P-2), petitioner submitted representation (Annexure P-3) seeking compassionate appointment, which has been followed by numerous representations and

legal notice (Annexure P-7), but to no avail. Counsel submits that petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to look into legal notice (Annexure P-7) in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.
4. On asking of the Court, Mr.Pankaj Middha, Additional Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.
5. Given the nature of order being passed, this Court does not deem it necessary to call for a response from the respondents.
6. Having heard counsel for the parties, but without commenting upon the claim of the petitioner as raised in the writ petition or in the representations and legal notice, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to examine the legal notice (Annexure P-7) within a period of four months from the date of communication of copy of this order. In case, respondent No.3 finds that claim as raised in the legal notice cannot be accepted, a speaking order be passed assigning reasons for rejection within the aforesaid period.
