1. This is a civil writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction especially in the nature of certiorari to set aside the orders / letters dated 06.11.2018 and 13.11.2018 (Annexure P-5/5-A) and order dated 02.06.2020 (Annexure P-6) passed by the respondents. Other prayers have also been made in the present writ petition.

2. Learned State counsel has referred to a letter dated 15.06.2023, a copy of which has been taken on record as Mark A along with other documents submitted and as per which, letter dated 06.11.2018 which provided for filing application for review in Form II has been withdrawn and it has further been stated that it would be open to the schools to apply for review of recognition on New Online Application developed under the

Online Portal for private schools instead of applying in Form II. It is
