The petitioners have moved the instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India before this Court for issuance of directions to respondents No. 1 to 4 to protect their life and liberty as they had performed marriage against the wish of the private respondents.

On notice, a short reply has been filed by way of affidavit of Station House Officer, Police Station Mahilpur, District Hoshiarpur on behalf of the respondents No. 1 to 3. Learned State counsel has submitted that the police of Police Station Mahilpur, District Hoshiarpur did not receive any representation as mentioned in the present petition. However, the police of Police Station Mahilpur, District Hoshiarpur, is ready and willing to provide police protection to the petitioners, in case, they approach the said police station and some threat to their life and liberty, is found.

In view of the statement made by the learned State counsel, nothing survives in the present petition and the same is, accordingly, disposed off.
