This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for quashing of complaint No. 649/2015 dated 20.09.2012 (Annexure P-2) and summoning order dated 13.05.2016 (Annexure P-3), passed by learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Amritsar.
