Petitioner No.2 was earlier married with respondent No.4-Paramjit Kaur, but they were divorced, vide order dated 02.03.2023 passed by learned Family Court, Sri Muktsar Sahib, copy of that order has been placed on record. Both the petitioners are now residing live-in relationship and are facing threats from respondent No4, from whom petitioner No.2 has already been got divorced. Petitioners have also placed on record the copy of application dated 04.04.2023 (Annexure P-3), which was moved to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib.

In the meantime, respondent Nos.2 and 3 are hereby directed to provide necessary protection to the petitioners after considering threat perception to their life.
