Prayer in this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of order dated 24.01.2017 (Annexure P-6) and for issuance of directions to the official respondents to hold a fair and transparent inquiry into the complaint dated 14.03.2016 (Annexure P-1).

Reply by way of affidavit dated 12.10.2018 of Jaspal Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Jalalabad, District Fazilka has been filed by respondent-State and the same is taken on record.

The relevant paragraph of the aforesaid affidavit reads as under:

“That despite of the fact that this Hon’ble High Court has already declared the matter in question being of civil in nature and further the complaints of the petitioner has already been enquired and filed but nevertheless, the petitioner is misusing the process of law by continuing with his act of filing the complaints with same allegations to the different public

machineries i.e. Punjab State Commission of NRI's, at Chandigarh, Inspector General of Police NRI & Women Wing, at Mohali and all these complaints were also marked to respondent No.2 and upon its enquiries, these complaints have been filed due to civil nature of the dispute."

It is informed by learned State counsel that the proceedings with regard to separation of the couple is pending in the competent Courts at United States. It is further informed that cancellation report qua the instant FIR has also been filed.

In light of the aforesaid factual position and the statement made by learned State counsel, the present petition has become infructuous.

Disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
