Prayer in the present petition is for quashing the impugned order dated 25.01.2019 (Annexure P-5) passed by respondent No.2; order dated 01.06.2018 (Annexure P-4) passed by respondent No.3; order dated 08.03.2017 (Annexure P-3) passed by respondent No.4 and order dated 30.11.2016 (Annexure P-2) passed by respondent No.5 being totally illegal, arbitrary and against the principles of natural justice.

There is a written request for adjournment on behalf of learned counsel for the petitioner. Perusal of the file shows that from the last three consecutive dates i.e. 09.03.2022, 23.08.2022 and 04.07.2023, no one was present on behalf of the petitioner. Today also, learned proxy counsel appearing for the petitioner prays for an adjournment. It is apparent that the petitioner's counsel is prolonging the proceeding by

seeking adjournments on one pretext or the other. The case is pending since 2019 and no serious efforts have been made to argue the same. So the prayer made is declined.

In view of the above, present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
