Prayer in the present petition is for quashing on merits of FIR No.0092 dated 14.06.2019 under Sections 406 & 498-A of IPC, 1860 and Section 4-B of Dowry Prohibition Act, 1976, registered at Police Station Sadar Hoshiarpur, District Hosiarpur (Annexure P-1) along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2/complainant submits that after filing of the present petition, the parties had entered into a compromise, and said FIR in question has already been quashed on the basis of said compromise by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 10.02.2023 passed in CRM-M-39869-2022.

Learned State counsel admits the above said fact and supplied a copy of order dated 15.03.2023 passed by the trial Court whereby both the accused/petitioner herein has been discharged in pursuance to the above order dated 10.02.2023.

A perusal of order sheet reveals that from the last two dates

there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner and Registry was directed to inform the learned counsel for the petitioner.

Office report shows that learned counsel for the petitioner was duly informed still there is no representation on his behalf even today.

In view of the above submissions made by learned counsel for respondent No.2/complainant and learned State counsel, no further direction is warranted in the present case.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of as infructuous.
