The petitioner seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari quashing the impugned order dated 16.09.2022 (Annexure P-11), whereby the respondents withdrew the order dated 06.09.2021 (Annexure P-1) in an arbitrary and illegal manner. A further prayer is made for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to consider Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET) equivalent to the State Teacher Eligibility Test (STET)/Haryana Teacher Eligibility Test (HTET) for all intents and purposes, for the post of Trained Graduate Teacher (TGT) Sanskrit and allow the petitioner to participate in the selection process, provisionally.

At the outset, learned State counsel submits that the issue involved in the present case is similar to the one contained in CWP-5864-2023 titled as 'Annu Vs. State of Haryana and others', which has already

been dismissed by this Court vide a detailed order dated 21.03.2023 and prays for dismissal of the present petition in the same terms.

In view of the detailed order dated 21.03.2023 passed by this Court in CWP-5864-2023 titled as ‘Annu Vs. State of Haryana and others’, the present petition is dismissed.
