This criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus with a roving writ directing the respondent Nos.1 and 3 to produce the detenue namely Baljit Kaur aged 24 years, who is daughter of the petitioner and is stated to be in illegal custody of respondent No.4.

Mr. Sumeet Puri, Advocate has caused appearance on behalf of detenue-Baljit Kaur and filed his power of attorney which is taken on record.

Detenue-Baljeet Kaur is present in Court. She has made a statement that she is living with Mr. Pawan Kumar at her own will and has not been kidnapped by him.
