JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (ORAL)

1. On 17.04.2023, the following order was passed:-

“Through instant petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Code, 1973, the petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in Criminal Complaint No. COMI/2/2019 dated 08.01.2019, titled as “Rajneet Kaur vs. Davinder Kumar and another” registered at Police Station Guruharshai, District Ferozepur, under Sections 307, 406, 498-A, 325, 324, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860.

Learned counsel for the petitioners inter alia contends that the complainant lodged DDR against her husband and petitioners are in-laws of the complainant. In the DDR, the petitioners were not implicated. The police after completing investigation did not find any substance in the complaint and FIR

was not registered. The complainant has filed a complaint against her husband and her in-laws i.e. father-in-law and brother-in-law. As per complainant, the alleged incident took place on 15.02.2018 and DDR was registered on 24.02.2018 and complaint before trial Court has been filed on 08.01.2019. The complainant has improved her version in the complaint because there was no allegation against the petitioners in the DDR. The petitioner is not involved in any other offence. The petitioners are permanent resident of District Ferozepur. The petitioners are ready to join investigation and face trial. There is no possibility of flee from justice. The arrest would cause irreparable loss, mental agony, embarrassment and humiliation to petitioner as well entire family. Case of the petitioner is squarely covered by decision of Hon'ble Supreme Court in Ansar Mohammad Vs. The State of Rajasthan.

Notice of motion returnable for 02.05.2023.

Mr. Amish Sharma, Asstt. A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No. 1-State.

Mr. Amit Kumar Gupta, Advocate has filed his power of attorney on behalf of respondent No.2, which is taken on record.

In the meantime, if the petitioners surrender before the trial Court within a week from today, the trial Court shall release them on furnishing of bail bonds to its satisfaction.”

2. As per order dated 20.04.2023 passed by Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Guruharshai, District Ferozepur, the petitioner have

appeared before Trial Court and furnished bail bonds which stand accepted.

3. In view of furnishing of bail bonds and release of petitioners on regular bail, no further order is warranted.
