In the affidavit of Accountant General (A&E), Punjab, following observations are made: -

“That the pension Sanctioning Authority of the petitioner i.e. Commandant, 2nd India Reserve BN, Laddakothi, Sangrur, submitted the pension papers of the petitioner vide letter dated 05/05/2023. The office of the deponent has authorized/finalized by way of issuing e-RPPO intimation authority No.Pen-06/intimation/23-24/PE/23/15/80566537 dated 31.07.2023, Annexure R-3 whereby 100% family pension has been sanctioned in favour of Smt. Kamaljeet Kaur, wife of the petitioner.

In view of the above submission, at present no further action as sought to be projected by the petitioner in this contempt petition, is pending on the part of the deponent.

It is therefore respectfully prayed that the present contempt petition as against the deponent may kindly be dismissed and the Rule discharged.”

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this petition may be disposed of having become as infructuous.
